

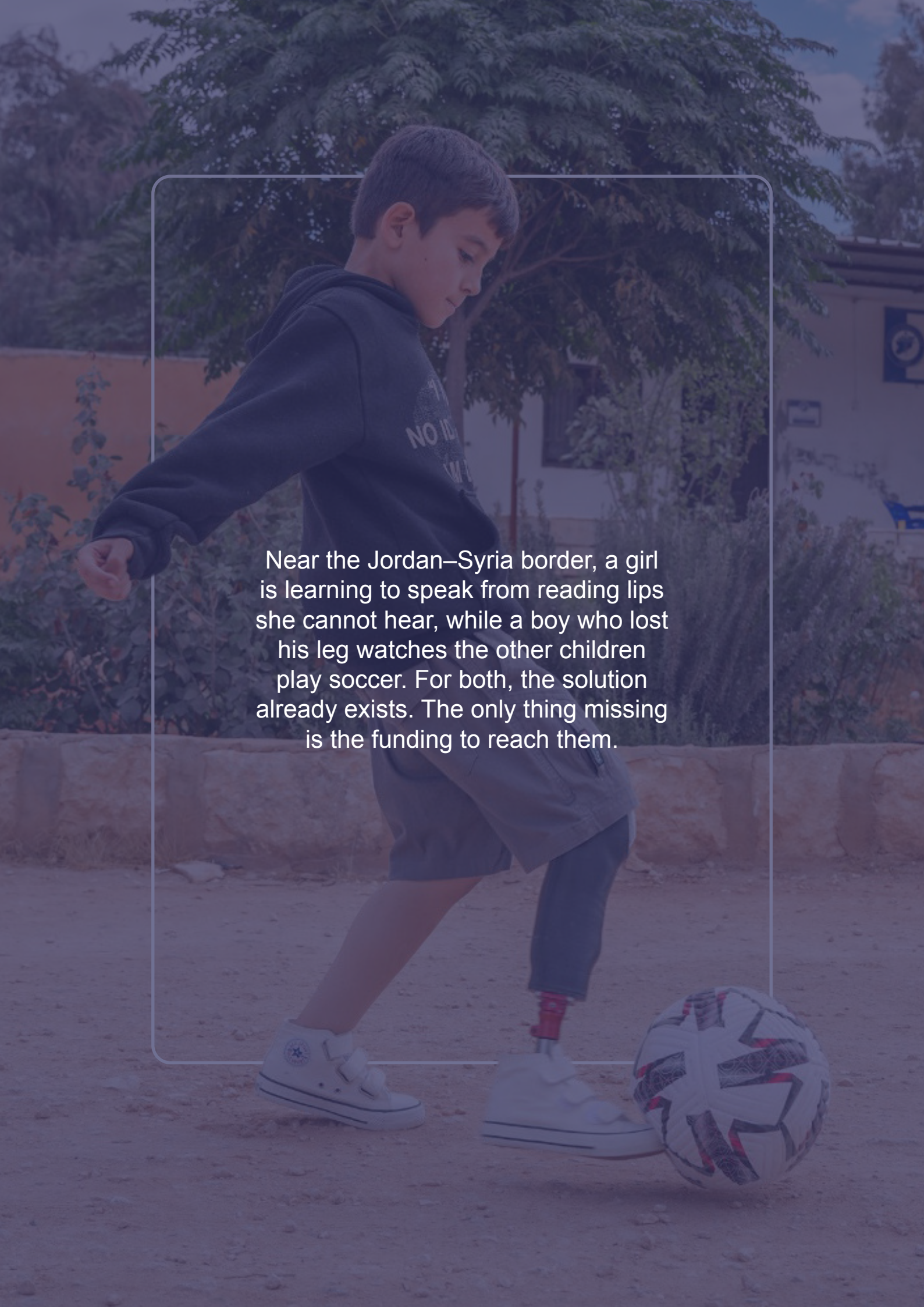

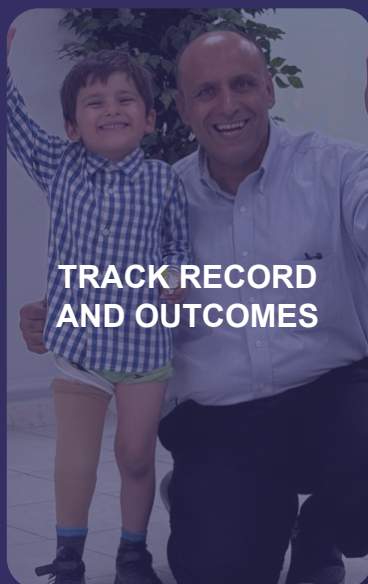

WHO WE ARE

3DP4ME applies 3D-printing technology to deliver affordable, custom assistive medical devices to children and adults in conflict-affected and low-resource communities across Jordan and Syria. Founded in 2017 and based in Amman, the organization runs two programs: Hearing Express, which produces 3D-printed hearing aids, and Step by Step, which produces 3D-printed lower-limb prosthetics. We pair specialized technical and clinical expertise with deep local presence, including cross-border delivery, to reach people the system has left behind.

What sets 3DP4ME apart is a combination of clinical capability and local embeddedness that no other organization in the region currently offers.

Our team includes:



A prosthetist with more than 30 years of experience who formerly led the Jordanian Army's prosthetics unit.

A 3D engineer who previously worked with Doctors Without Borders.

A world-class **program manager**, who previously worked at Ericsson (Telecom).

Two U.S. doctoral-level, Arabic-speaking **physical therapists**.

A prosthetist with 20 years' experience already operating in Damascus.

The infrastructure is already in place, and this is a proven, operating model that is ready to scale.

Amman (Jordan)

a 250-square-meter facility housing a 3D-printing lab and prosthetics workshop.

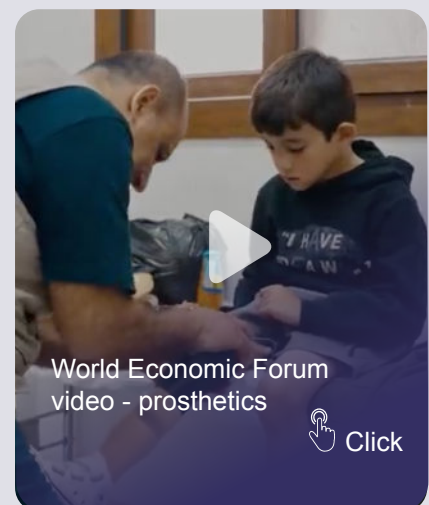
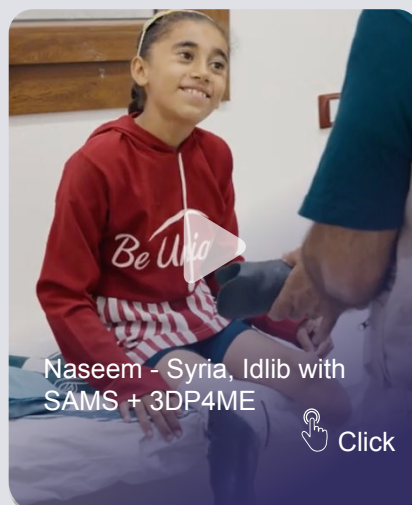
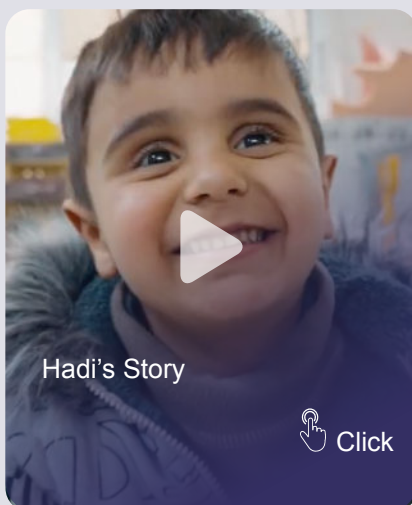
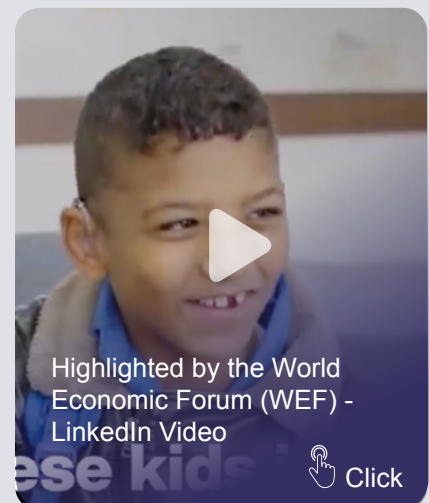
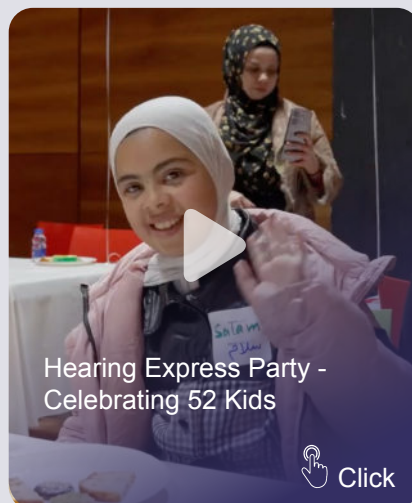
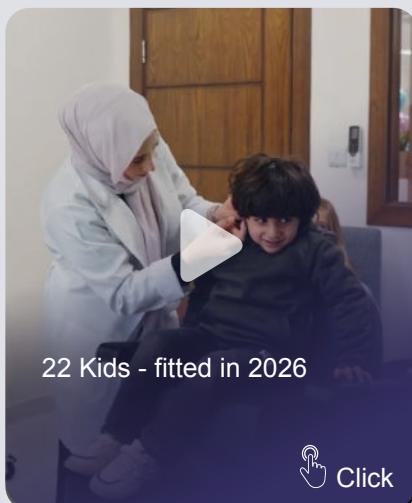
Damascus (Syria)

THE OPPORTUNITY

Demand far exceeds current capacity. Thousands of children across the region remain without access to hearing or mobility care, a gap that would take over a decade to close at today's pace. Every year of delay costs a child language, mobility, and schooling they can never fully recover, and these interventions work best early in childhood.

Your generous gifts will allow us to hit our campaign goal of \$1,000,000, sized to transform 3DP4ME expansion both its capacity and reach. The model has already been proven for both hearing and prosthetics. The technology works. The clinical expertise is in place. Local partnerships have been established. Catalytic dollars help us expand into new territory and increase our impact.

140 Prosthetics Patients (10% Bilateral)

Geographic expansion: extending service into
Aleppo and areas north and west of Damascus.

TRACK RECORD AND OUTCOMES



3DP4ME has fitted 52 patients with 3D-printed prosthetics

to date in Jordan & Syria, and currently produces roughly six prostheses per month.

Cost-effectiveness

The fitting cost is approximately \$2,000 per prosthesis and \$1,375 per hearing-aid patient (one pair). Additional cost would provide the full care continuum: physiotherapy, psychosocial support, family education, maintenance, speech therapy, batteries, and outcome tracking.

66 kids are hearing and thriving today

from the Hearing Express program, 3DP4ME developed the patient-engagement, family-education, and long-term follow-up systems that anchor its holistic care model, achieving an 88% device continued-use rate after two years.



PARTNERSHIPS: CREDIBILITY AND REACH

3DP4ME's cross-border model is possible because of deep partnerships with the clinical, governmental, and technical institutions that provide access, referrals, and reach across Jordan and Syria:



Clinical and governmental partners:

the Higher Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (HCD), Jordan's government partner; SAMS (Syrian American Medical Society), providing patient identification and access under a formal MOU; and in collaboration with the Ibin Alnafees Hospital (Damascus) and Ministry of Health, supporting delivery on the ground in Syria.



Technical and manufacturing partners:

Proteor, ASIGA, Detax, Hanger, and Cyfex, supplying the components, printing hardware, and prosthetic and audiological technology that make custom devices possible.



Academic and research partners:

the Technical University of Munich (TUM) and University College London (UCL), supporting research and evaluation.



Logistics, corporate, and institutional supporters:

DHL, Accenture, Intel, the World Economic Forum, Australian Aid, and Ahli Bank.

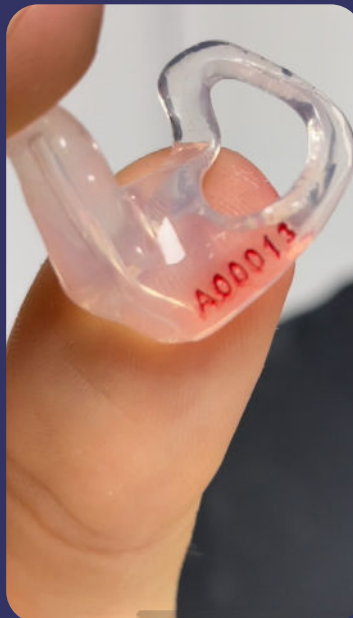
